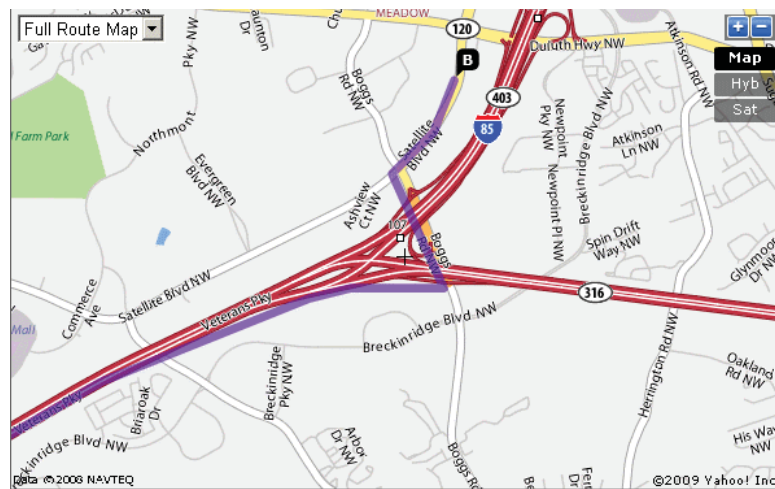
Directions

From I-85 Northbound

- ☒ I-85 N toward GREENVILLE
- ☒ Take RIGHT fork onto GA-316 E toward LAWRENCEVILLE/ATHENS (exit #105)
- ☒ Take the BOGGS ROAD EXIT (the exit is approximately 1.5 miles in length); continue until you reach Boggs Road.
- ☒ Turn left onto Boggs Rd. (travel 0.4 miles).
- ☒ Turn right onto Satellite Blvd. (travel 0.4 miles).

Look for three red-brick office buildings on the left, before the next traffic light at Duluth Highway (GA-120). The McCart Group is in the largest of the three buildings.



From I-85 Southbound

- ☒ Take I-85 S toward ATLANTA
- ☒ Take exit #107 / LAWRENCEVILLE (GA-316 E)/DULUTH toward GA-120
- ☒ Take GA-120 exit
- ☒ Turn right onto Duluth Hwy / GA-120 W
- ☒ Turn left at the first light onto Satellite Blvd.
